IPCI to address controversial videos by local church

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IPCI to address controversial videos by local church

The Islamic Propagation Centre International (IPCI) has clapped back with a phenomenal gesture of goodwill towards Revival Ministries by offering them an educational discussion on their religion.

The IPCI said that this was in order to debunk the misconceptions regarding the Islamic faith. In an open letter addressed to the church, Advocate Yusuf Ismail, head of academia and research at IPCI, acknowledged the recent social media posts and viral video regarding the Islamophobic and Hinduophobic remarks made by representatives of

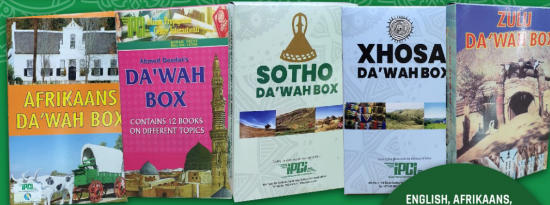
the church.

In the viral video the representatives ask, "Why would a Muslim man worship Jesus?" and further comments stating, "Why would every religion give their life to Jesus?"

Ismail said: "It seems one or both of you are not educated on what Islam is and what Muslims believe in as compared to what Christians believe. If you were, you would refrain from such inflammatory statements. On the grounds of freedom of expression, the body requested for both of the representatives to allow the IPCI to

educate the congregation on what Islam is and what Muslims believe in at any public hall in Chatsworth of the church's choice for which the IPCI will bear the cost of." He added: "More favorable to us will be at your church's Twin City venue, for the use of which, we will contribute towards the interactive discussion in terms of which you will also address the audience. We anticipate a positive response in this regard and look forward to this potential symposium." Revival Ministries has acknowledged the open letter and stated that they will communicate further with the organisation, in due time, as to what will happen next.

- 15 Males, all non Muslim, average age 30 years old, mainly indigent, attended program from 14h00 to 16h00.
- Very eager to change their lives. One brother Embraced Islam. has a problem attending Mosque. says he needs to be clean, he is on the street.
- However Brother Ebrahim Essack Afgani, former IPCI Madresa arcade staff and this programs coordinator, knows him well has been counselling him over few months, took his Shahadah.
- Says that he has potential and is worth investing time and effort in him. Alhumdullilah.
- Brother Ebrahim Essack has been doing Dawah in this area for 3 years and work for Westcliff Pharmacy situated in the Same Area and does Dawah every day when he is doing his deliveries.
- The IPCI is looking for a Generous Muslim to donate or lease to the Centre a house in Chatsworth.
- We have found that the most ideal setup for our Dawah in the Suburbs is this type of a HOUSE converted to a MUSJID setup. We require the use of it for the following activities:
 - * Place for Prayer
 - * Place to Teach New Muslims Islam and Salaah
 - * Place for New Reverts. HALF WAY HOUSE to stay for 15 Days try out period after Shahadah.
 - * Dawah Course students to stay for 10 days CR course
 - * Trained Duat to go out from here on Street Dawah and base for operations.
 - * Madressah classes for children
