IPCI SUCCEFULL EID DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAM FOR REVERTS

Sunday, 23 April 2023, As Salaamu alaykum wrb.

I wish to convey my appreciation to IPCI for hosting the Eid event for new reverts. My helper came to me on the first day of Ramadan and decided to revert and fasted the whole month Alhumdu Lillah. When she came back from the program she was so happy. She met other Sotho speaking people with whom she could relate to. Being a revert has its own set of challenges, apart from having your entire foundation of understanding shaken and having to relearn and unlearn years of conditioning, you have to deal with family/ colleagues & friends who are unhappy and unaccepting to your reversion.



The Eid for reverts program provided a safe and welcoming environment where new Muslims could discuss their challenges, get advice or just create new social relationships.

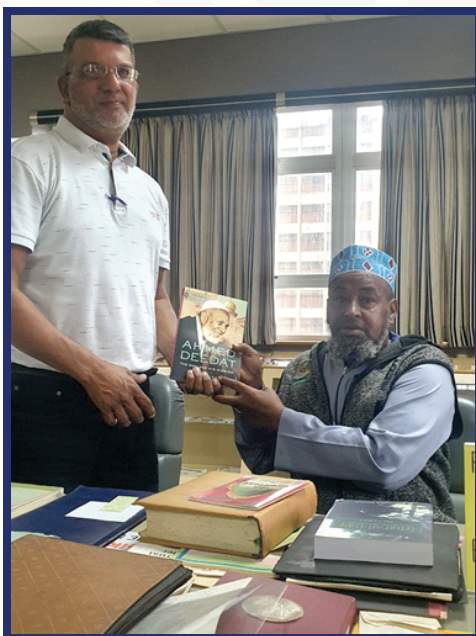
This is the feedback I got from my helper :

1. She asked the Muslim ladies that she met how they broke the news to their families and how did they get their families to accept them. Most of the ladies did not have that challenge as they had entered into Islam through marriage with a Muslim.
2. How did they deal with children and parents: They said that young children were easy as they follow the religion of their parents, but with the older children and parents , some accepted their family members reversion while others did not.
3. She met one non-Muslim lady who was married to a Muslim but had not yet reverted. She was asked why she reverted and she said that after reading and researching she found out that Islam was the only truth. She made her new friend promise to listen to Lesedi FM every Sunday morning at 5am because that was the programme that most influenced her about Islam.
4. Although we asked the organisers to keep an eye on our helper and make sure that she was comfortable, she was careful to point out that everyone present, other Muslims who had just come were so warm and good to her.
5. She was so impressed with the good manners of the Muslim children present.
6. She said that she felt at home and welcomed.

I feel that social networks, post reversion programs and support for new Muslims (social/ educational/ vocational/ self development etc) are integral in creating and keeping them anchored in the ummah of 'Ukhrijat Lin Naas'. The growth, success and self development of the new Muslims will be the best Dawah to their non Muslim communities.

Jazaak Allahu khair to the IPCI team for doing the Eid program for reverts and New Muslims with so much of Ihsaan and Ithqan. May this be heavy on your scales Ameen.
