MESSAGE FROM AMEER

Bismillahir Rahmanir Rahim

We thank Almighty Allah for His assistance and blessings in our Dawah activities, and we sincerely thank all our donors for their continued support. Alhamdulillah, IPCI has made significant progress in Dawah both in South Africa and abroad.

To name some of our activities:

- Our Dawah outreaches have expanded to university campuses and colleges, including UKZN, DUT, MUT, WITS, TUKS, and UJ.
- One of our major achievements has been the development of a comprehensive 15-module Comparative Religion (CR) syllabus. This curriculum is now used for IPCI Dawah courses at the Centre and online via Zoom and is available to Dawah institutions and individuals. It covers Islam in comparison with Christianity, Judaism, African Traditional Religion, Hinduism, Atheism, and modern ideologies. Alhamdulillah, several Darul Uloom have shown interest, with some deciding to adopt the syllabus into their programmes. This has been facilitated by the IPCI Head of Comparative Religion being an Aalim who specialises in this field.
- We have also revived the Ahmed Deedat Annual Lecture Series (ADALS), which was highly successful and highlighted the importance of spirituality in Dawah. This was further reinforced during the Visionaries three-day spiritual retreat held in the Drakensberg in 2024, attended by participants from across South Africa and Southern Africa. In 2025 we hosted Shaykh Abdullah al-Andalusi for a 3 day retreat in Kamberg Mountain Shadows Resort for a masterclass on “The Madhaahib of the West”.
- Among our longstanding initiatives is the “Visit to the Mosque” guided tour programme, a flagship activity since 1958. This is especially popular at our Cape Town branch, located near the historic Awwal Mosque.

• Other key activities include the Dawah Quran Project, where we engage Muslim-owned businesses, distribute Qurans and Dawah material, conduct follow-ups, facilitate Shahadahs, and offer revert classes.

• The management of our branches across South Africa (Phoenix, Umlazi, Chatsworth, Port Shepstone, Polokwane, Cape Town, Durban CBD).

• Supplying Dawah material and Qurans locally and internationally, including to Nigeria, Namibia, Botswana, and Eswatini.

• Conducting weekly radio programmes in English and Zulu and regular participation in radio panels and podcasts.

• Outreach efforts to domestic workers are ongoing through visits to flats and gated communities, with the assistance of Muslim residents.

• The most vital function of IPCI remains the printing and distribution of the Holy Qur'an and Islamic literature in multiple languages. Demand for these resources continues to grow, and Alhamdulillah, IPCI is among the largest suppliers in South Africa and abroad.

All these efforts are made possible through the generosity of our donors. May Allah SWT bless you, accept your duas and ibadah, and grant you a blessed Eid.

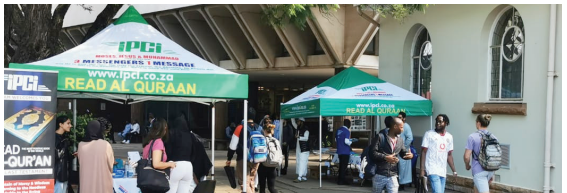

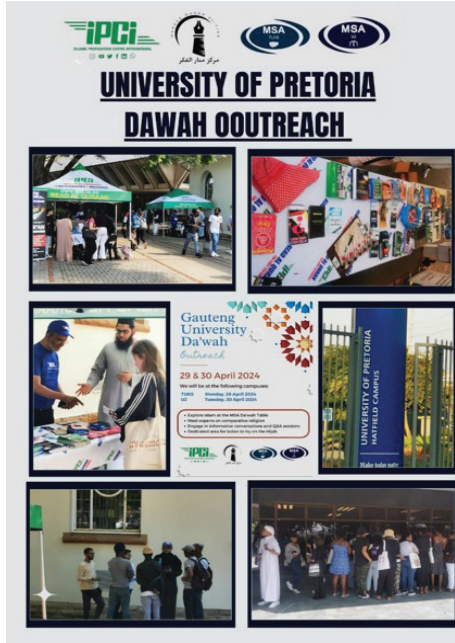

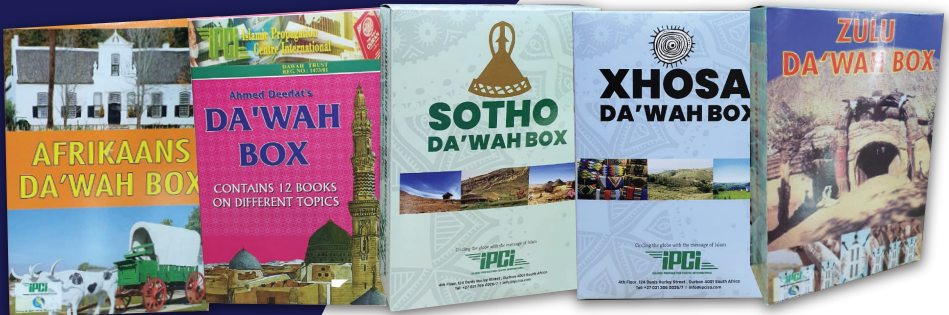
PRINT & PUBLICATIONS

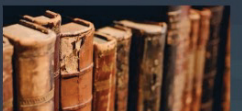


SHORT INTENSIVE 6 DAYS COURSE

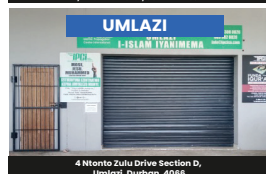
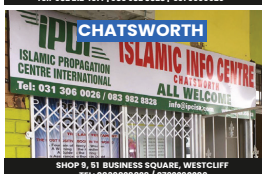
